## **Community Oncology Association (COA) Annual Meeting**

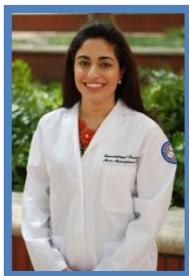


**Brian Ramnaraign, MD**

**Barbara L. McAneny, MD, FASCO, MACP**  
President-Elect  
American Medical Association

**BIOGRAPHY:** Barbara L. McAneny, MD, a board-certified medical oncologist/hematologist from Albuquerque, N.M., was elected president-elect of the American Medical Association in June 2017. Dr. McAneny has served on the AMA Board of Trustees since 2010, including as its chair in 2015–2016. An impressive leader, Dr. McAneny has been a member of the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) Board of Directors, president of the New Mexico Medical Society (NMMS), president of the Greater Albuquerque Medical Association, and president of the New Mexico Chapter of the American College of Physicians.

Currently Dr. McAneny chairs the board of the National Cancer Care Alliance, which she founded to help independent oncology practices remain independent by sharing resources and best practices. A fellow of the ASCO and a master of the American College of Physicians, she became the delegate to the AMA from the ASCO in 2002, and was elected to the AMA Council of Medical Service in 2003, serving as its chair in 2009–2010.

Dr. McAneny was appointed to the Practicing Physicians Advisory Council from 2002 to 2006 and was a founding member of Oncology Circle, a group of oncology practices using data to promote best practices. She is also a member of the Community Oncology Alliance Board of Trustees and served on the board of directors of the Cancer Center Business Summit. She has previously chaired Albuquerque's Emergency Medical Services Authority for 20 years, from 1990 to 2010.

In 2012 Dr. McAneny received a \$19.8 million award from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Innovation to test how oncology private practices could provide cancer patients better care at a lower cost. This award, called COME HOME (for Community Oncology Medical Home), later helped form Medicare's Oncology Care Model. Innovative Oncology Business Solutions Inc., the company she created to manage the award, is now assisting physician practices, in collaboration with ASCO, in developing the process changes needed for MACRA.

Among other volunteer activities, she has served on the governor of New Mexico's Task Force on Prenatal Care, the board of Planned Parenthood of New Mexico, and as chair of the joint task force of the NMMS and the New Mexico Bar Association on domestic violence. A recipient of a New Mexico Woman on the Move Award in 2005 and Woman of Influence Award in 2009, Dr. McAneny has been voted several times by her peers as Albuquerque The Magazine's "Top Doc" in her specialty.

She co-founded New Mexico Oncology Hematology Consultants Ltd. in 1987. A managing partner since 1999, she built New Mexico Cancer Center, which provides outpatient medical and radiation oncology care and imaging in Albuquerque and the underserved area of Gallup. She also founded the New Mexico Cancer Center Foundation, which provides grants to help patients with nonmedical expenses.

Dr. McAneny graduated magna cum laude from the University of Minnesota in 1973 and with honors from the University of Iowa College of Medicine in 1977. She completed her residency in internal medicine at the University of Iowa in 1980 and her fellowship in hematology/oncology at the University of New Mexico in 1984.

**BIOGRAPHY:** Dr. Edgardo Santos practices at the Center for Hematology-Oncology (CHO) and is an Associate Professor of Clinical Biomedical Sciences at Florida Atlantic University, and Vice Chairman of the FLASCO Membership Committee. He earned his M.D. in 1994 at the University of Panama, School of Medicine, Republic of Panama. Dr. Santos completed his internship and residency training in Internal Medicine at Jackson Memorial Medical Center, University of Miami School of Medicine, Miami, Florida. Then, he went on to complete his fellowship in Hematology/Oncology at the Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center, Miami, Florida. Dr. Santos has authored or co-authored several manuscripts in peer-reviewed journals and also serves as reviewer for several scientific publications. Dr. Santos is a member of the Editorial Board of Expert Review series, Recent Patents on Biomarkers, and Clinical Practice. He has lectured mostly on topics related to lung and head and neck cancers as well as lymphoproliferative disorders and multiple myeloma.

Dr. Santos was a former faculty member of University of Miami Miller School of Medicine, Miami, Florida where he hold an academic rank as an Associate Professor of Medicine (2008-2012) and Tulane University Health Sciences Center, New Orleans, Louisiana (2004-2008). Dr. Santos has occupied several administrative, educational, and research leadership positions including Tulane University Principal Investigator at Southwest Oncology Group (SWOG), Associate Scientific Director of Tulane Cancer Center's Office of Clinical Research, Associate Director of the Fellowship Programs (Tulane University and University of Miami), Chief of the Hematology/Oncology Section at the Southeast Louisiana Veterans Healthcare System, Chair of the Committee Research Advisory Board, Co-Leader of Clinical Research for the Louisiana Cancer Research Consortium, Co-Leader of the Head and Neck Cancer Program at Sylvester Cancer Center, and many others. He is an active member of the International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer where he is the Chair of Publication Committee, member of the Educational Committee for the World Congress on Lung Cancer in 2018 (Toronto, Canada), and the Scientific Chair of 2018 LALCA Congress (Cordoba, Argentina); the American Association for Cancer Research, the American Society of Clinical Oncology where he is the Past Chair of the Membership Committee, the European Society of Medical Oncology, the American Society of Hematology, and the American College of Physicians-American Society of Internal Medicine. Dr. Santos is also a member of the Addario Lung Cancer Medical Institute (ALCMI) which is focused in developing personalized medicine in this field. He also delivers his expert opinion at the Multimodality Clinics for lung cancer. Dr. Santos' main interests are the conduction and development of early phases of clinical trials.



## **Program Co Vice Chairman**

**Joseph D. Rosenblatt, MD**  
Chief, Hematology Division, DOM  
Miller School of Medicine  
University of Miami

**Biography:** Joseph D. Rosenblatt, M.D., is a Professor of Medicine, Microbiology and Immunology, and is Chief of the Hematology Division at the Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center (SCCC) at the University of Miami (UM). Dr Rosenblatt joined University of Miami in 2001, bringing extensive administrative and research experience. He holds a graduate cross appointment in the Department of Microbiology and Immunology at UM. Dr. Rosenblatt is also a member of the Sylvester Tumor Biology Program. In the past 20 years, Dr. Rosenblatt has published over 150 journal articles and chapters in the areas of human retroviruses, immune therapies for cancer, and human gene therapy. From 1986 to 1995, Dr. Rosenblatt had been a member of the faculty in Hematology Oncology (Associate Professor) and was elected an Associate Member of the Molecular Biology Institute at the UCLA School of Medicine. Dr. Rosenblatt then served at the University of Rochester from 1995-2001 as the James P. Wilmot Chair in Hematology-Oncology and Chief of the Hematology-Oncology Unit, and had a secondary appointment within the Department of Microbiology and Immunology. He has had continuous NIH and other extramural funding for retroviral, gene therapy and immunotherapy related research since 1986 and has previously been a standing member of the NCI Experimental Therapeutics II (ET-2), the Clinical Immunology and Immunotherapy II (C-II) study sections and more recently as a member of the Clinical Oncology Study section at the NCI. His research includes the synthesis and testing of novel antibody–fusion proteins which target the HER2 and EGFR cancer antigens which can inhibit angiogenesis or augment the immune response to breast and other cancers. He has also developed novel gene therapy approaches for use in lymphoma and chronic lymphocytic leukemia, and is currently exploring the role of B-cells in modulating the immune response to cancer in animal and human cancers. Dr. Rosenblatt completed a Fulbright Scholarship in 1990 at the Rabin Medical Center and is also a founding member of the Bar Ilan Faculty of Medicine in Safed, Israel. He is a nationally recognized expert in the treatment of lymphoma and other hematologic malignancies and maintains an active clinical practice. Dr. Rosenblatt lives in Hollywood with his wife of 40 years, Lily, and has two daughters Aliza and Eliana and one son, Joshua and four adorable grandchildren, Mattie Belle, Max, Aiden and Sheyn.

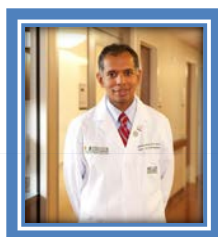
## **Moderator**

### **Albert Craig Lockhart, MD**

**Biography:** Dr. Lockhart is a Professor of Medicine and the Division Chief for the Division of Medical Oncology at the University of Miami – Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center. After completing his training at Duke, Dr. Lockhart was an assistant Professor of Medicine in the Division of Hematology/Oncology at Vanderbilt University. More recently, he served as the director of the Developmental Therapeutics program for the Siteman Cancer Center at Washington University from 2008-17.

Prior to moving to Miami in 2008, he was a faculty member at UCSF and at the University of Texas M.D. Anderson Cancer Center. His laboratory research is focused on studies of cancer immunology and has been widely published and supported by the NIH and cancer-related foundations.

Dr. Komanduri is the immediate Past-President of the American Society for Blood and Marrow Transplantation (ASBMT). He also serves as Co-Chair of the CIBMTR Working Committee on Infections and Immune Reconstitution and as a member of the Board of Directors of the National Marrow Donor Program (BeTheMatch) and as a member of the MIT NEWDIGS “think and do” tank on financing of novel curative therapies in oncology. He has also served as Chair of the Immunology and Host Defense Scientific Committee for the American Society of Hematology. He has been the recipient of awards including election to the American Society for Clinical Investigation (in 2009).

Dr. Naidoo graduated with her medical degree (MB BCh BAO) from Trinity College Dublin, and went on to complete both her internal medicine training and a medical oncology fellowship through the Royal College of Physicians of Ireland. She then completed an awarded advanced fellowship at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center (New York) from the Irish Society of Medical Oncology, and joined the faculty at Johns Hopkins in 2015. Since then, she has developed a portfolio of clinical trials and translational studies focused on immunotherapy for lung cancer, and immune-related toxicity.

Dr. Naidoo currently leads investigator-initiated trials for patient's lung cancer, specifically for patients with stage III non-small lung cancer, and those with CNS metastases. She is a leader in the field of immune-related toxicity, having published the first comprehensive analyses of pneumonitis (Best of J Clin Oncol 2017), bullous pemphigoid (Cancer Immunol Res 2016), as well as inflammatory arthritis (Ann Rheum Dis 2016) from anti-PD-1/PD-L1 agents. She is now the Chair of the Immunotherapy Subcommittee of the NRG Clinical Trials Cooperative Group, and serves on the NCCN Immune-Related Toxicity Panel. She is the recipient of several grants and awards including an NIH KL2 Clinical Scholar Award, American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) Merit Award, PRIME Young Investigator Award for NSCLC, and a Young Immuno-Oncologist's Award.
